CONVENTION DELEGATE AND ALTERNATE ALLOTMENTS/CERTIFICATIONS

Subject: Convention Delegate and Alternate Allotments/Certifications

In accordance with Article V, Sections 4-5-6-7-8 of the Detachment Constitution, the following is the procedure in establishing delegates and alternates to the Detachment Convention. Squadrons are to submit their delegates and alternates via the certification forms provided in the Squadron Program Manual.

Section 4: In the Sons of The American Legion, each Squadron shall be entitled to (1) delegate for every (10) members and (1) delegate for any fraction thereof, based on current membership ending (30) days prior to the opening session of the Detachment Convention and (1) alternate delegate for each delegate.

Section 5: Each duly registered delegate shall be entitled to (1) vote. Alternates for registered delegates shall have all privileges of registered delegates, except that of voting. A registered delegate is one who has received his credentials and has paid such registration fees as may be required.

Section 6: Delegates from (5) Squadrons shall constitute a quorum.

Section 7: All Past Detachment Commanders shall be delegates at large to the Convention, with voting privileges with their Squadrons. All Detachment Officers shall be delegates at large with voting privileges with their respective Squadrons.

Section 8: Where a County and/or District group is organized the Commander shall be a delegate at large with voting privileges with their respective Squadron.
